**POLICIES FOR PROGRAMS ESTABLISHED BY THE CITY OF RICHLAND FOR
THE PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT**

1. There shall be an Advisory Board consisting of seven (7) members appointed by the Parks and Recreation Director and Youth Coordinator and approved by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen. Their duties shall be to assist the Parks and Recreation in establishing and implementing recreational programs within the City of Richland. The Director of Parks and Recreation for the City of Richland shall have the final decision on any programs upon the approval of the Mayor and Board of Alderman.
2. The Advisory Board shall 1) establish rules for the selection of players and Allstars, 2) select coaches, 3) assist in any other areas as set forth by the Director and Youth Coordinator.
3. Coaches will be selected based on the following criteria:
 - a. Need
 - b. Past Experience
 - c. Prior record of performance
 - d. Confidential background check
 - e. Certification by National Youth Sports Program
4. All Players must live in the Richland School Zone or attend Richland Schools except as outlined by Little Dixie Rules.
5. All umpires shall be certified and paid at a rate shown on the attached rate sheet. Umpires will be supervised by the Parks and Recreation Director or his designee.
6. Rules of conduct are established by the City of Richland Parks and Recreation Department and approved by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen.
7. All rules of play shall be established by the Parks and Recreation Department as outlined by Little Dixie, Mississippi High School Athletic Association or other appropriate organizations.
8. Rules for special events or tournaments held on City property may be established by the Parks and Recreation Department.
9. All uniforms and equipment shall be purchased following State of Mississippi purchasing laws.
